TAIBEI (Taipei) (Seat of the Central Government)

FREE AREA OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA

Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen, Matsu, and the Pratas Islands constitute the Free Area of the Republic of China and claim sovereignty over the People's Republic of China.

The Republic of China and the People's Republic of China both claim the Paracel and Spratly Islands, not shown on this map. The PRC controls the Paracels (also claimed by Vietnam), while the Spratlys are disputed among several neighbouring countries.
