

Background Information

The Municipality of Chitungwiza is located south of Harare. It is the third largest municipality and the fastest growing population centre in Zimbabwe. Today's population count, including a migrant component, are estimated at approximately 2 million inhabitants.

This high density commuter town was formed in 1978 from the amalgamation of three townships: Seke, Zengeza and St. Mary's. It received full municipal status in 1981.
