

Large wooded areas are coloured green. These portions of rivers, streams, canals, tanks, &c. which generally contain water are shown in blue. The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved, Protected and State Forests are shown by green ribbons.

Large cultivated areas are coloured yellow. A relative height represents the approximate height in feet of the top above the bottom of a bench, cutting, &c. It is shown thus: 35. Contours are approximate.
