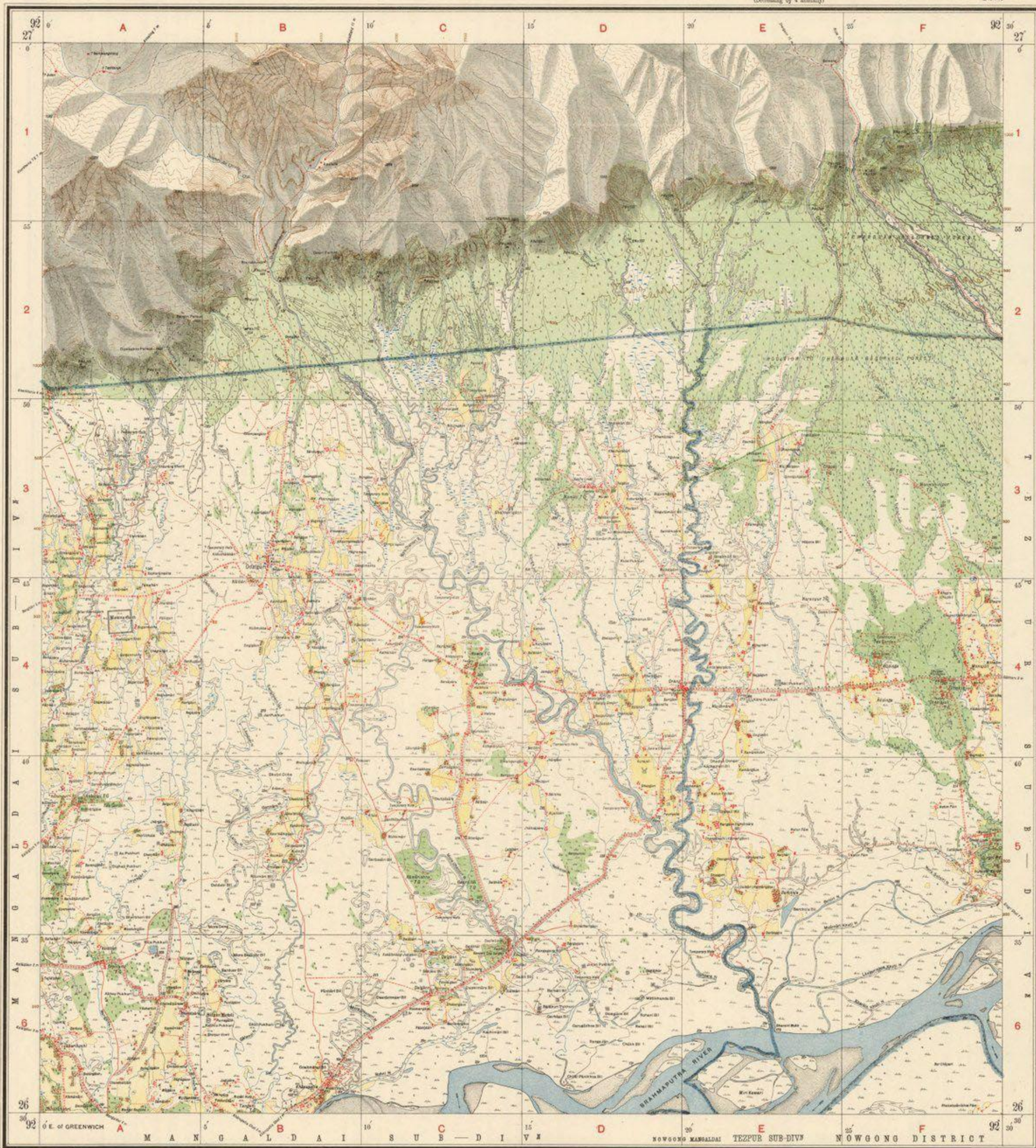

Large cultivated areas are coloured yellow. A relative height represents the approximate height in feet of the top above the bottom of a bank, cutting, &c. It is shown thus:—35. Contours are approximate.
