

Cainta Basic Information

The Municipality of Cainta is a first-class urban municipality in the province of Rizal, Philippines. It is the province's most prosperous town, one of the oldest (established 1571), and the town with the smallest land area (4296 has).

Cainta never ceases to be a gateway to the rest of Rizal province and is one of Rizal's most advanced towns because of its proximity to Manila. It is renowned for its colorful buildings (see below). The town is dubbed the "Spring Capital of the South." The event starts in celebration every two days in December.

Today Cainta has a robust economy as evidenced by several commercial and industrial establishments that have sprouted in the last 15 years. The town continues to attract businesses because of its proximity to Manila and the town's burgeoning population and mostly consists of hard-working and hospitable people.

The early part of the 21st century witnessed the founding of numerous manufacturing firms, including the Mercedes Motors Philippines, the largest car manufacturer in the country, and the World M/V San Corporation, one of the nation's leading small manufacturers.

There is also a proliferation of shopping malls, notably the Sta. Lucia Mall and the Business Plaza. One of the town's main attractions is the beautiful Metropolitan Village Golf and Country Club.

Recent years also saw the growth of outsourcing and call centers, among them a branch of Telecom Holdings, a Canadian-based firm, the first call center in the province of Rizal, with offices located on the 2nd floor of the Robinson's Plaza Cainta. Another is an even larger business located in the town's commercial center.

Cainta is also a substantial haven for business. It is one of the oldest trading bases in the 1570s. Others are Cainta Government, Vista Verde Executive Village, Village East, Vista Verde Country Homes, Dancers Village, Rainbow Village, Saint Anthony Subdivision, Welfare Village, Riverside Subdivision and many more.
