From the Summit to Edoya Hut, "The Yoshida Trail" and "The Subashiri Trail" are the same Route.

Turn left at the Shita-edoya hut to go on the Yoshida Trail.

The ascending route is marked in yellow.

From the Summit to Edoya Hut, please use the toilet at Fujisan Hotel.

If you are unable to get to the summit, turn around and walk back down the ascending trail.

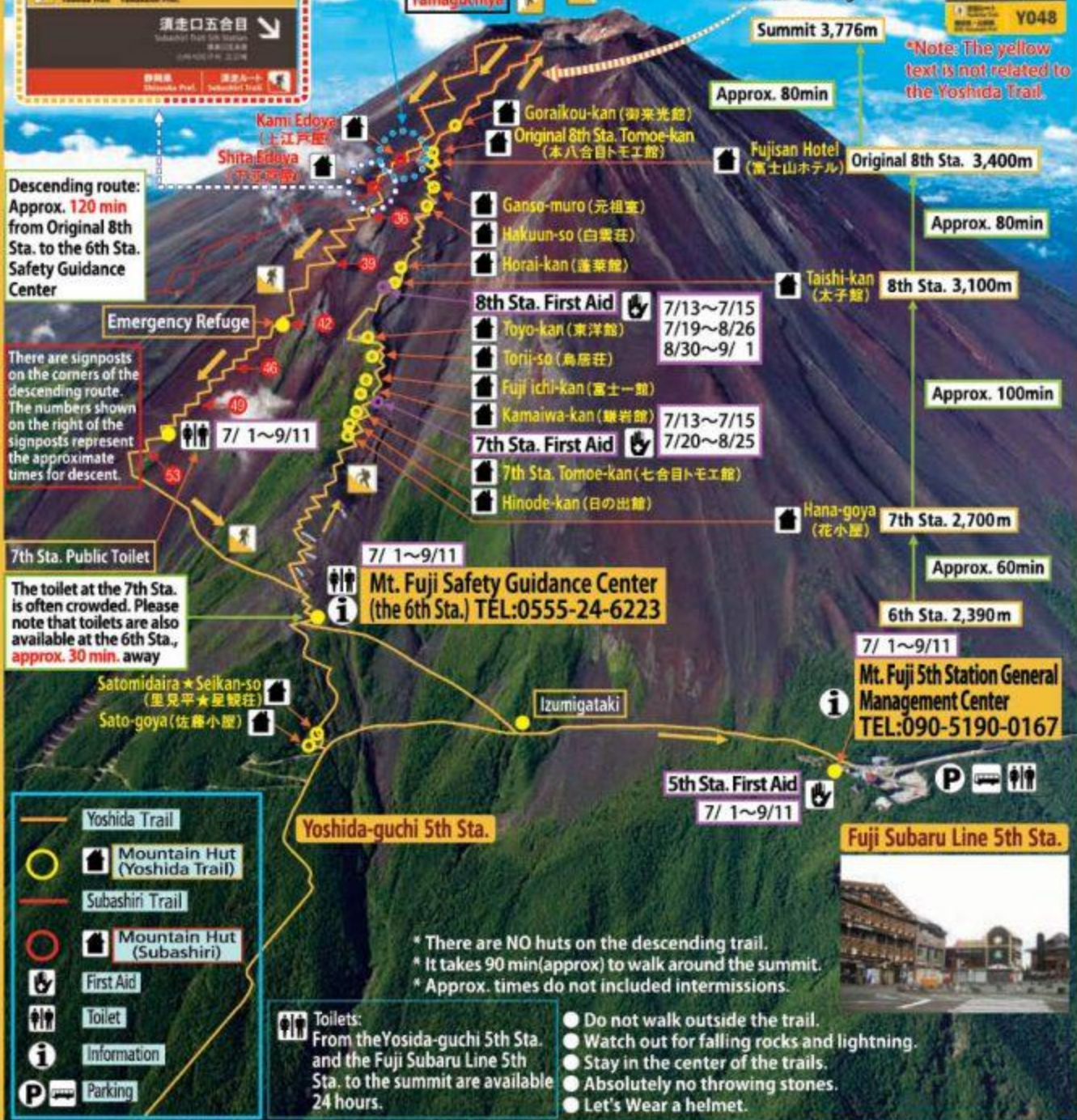
