

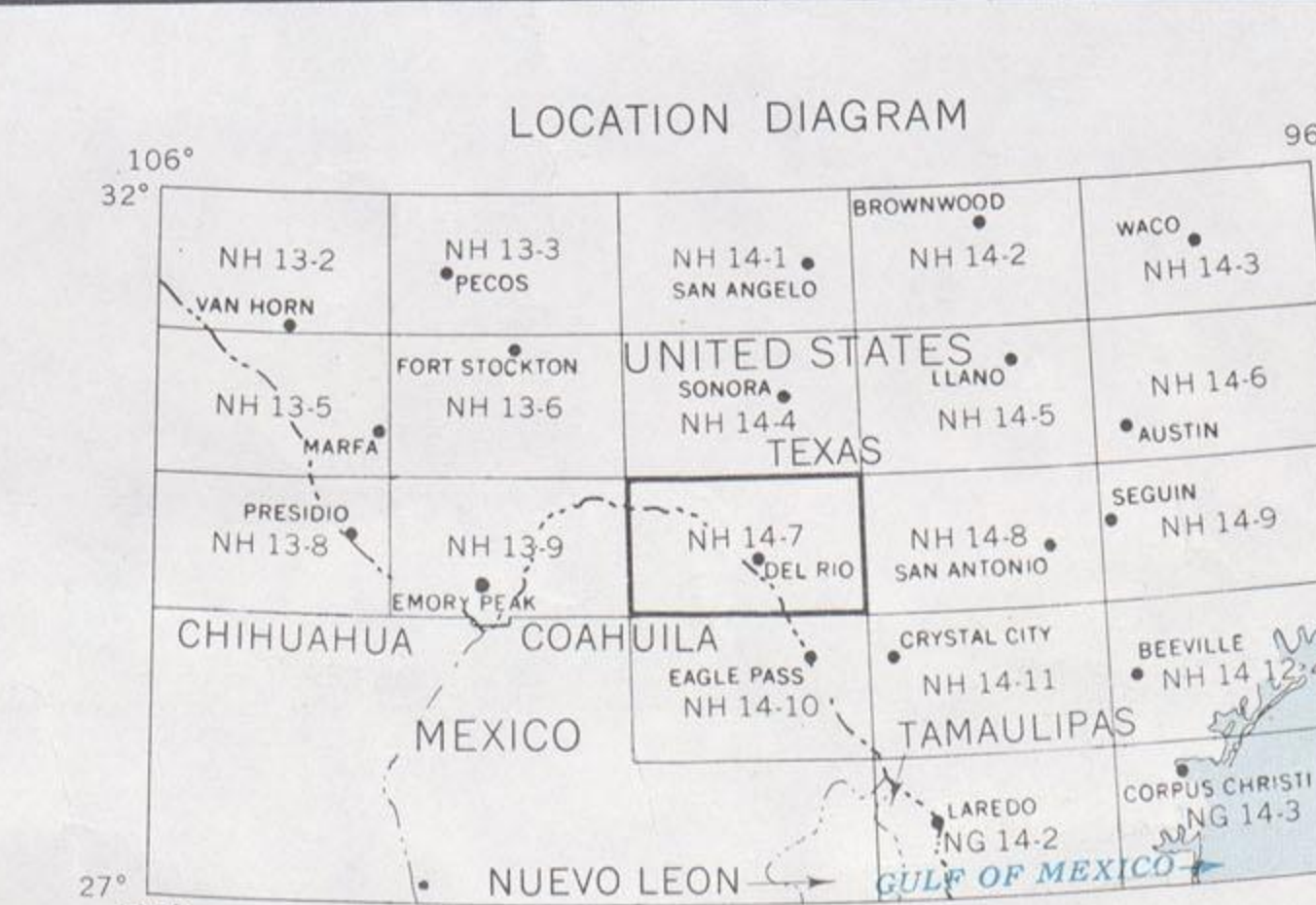

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GRID ZONE DESIGNATION: 14R
100,000 M. SQUARE IDENTIFICATION

TO ONE A STANDARD REFERENCE ON THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 100 METRES
SAMPLE POINT: CATIA VALLEY

1. Read letters identifying 100,000 metre square in which the point lies.
2. Locate first VERTICAL grid line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the top or bottom margin.
3. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
4. Locate first HORIZONTAL grid line BELOW point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the left or right margin, or on the line itself.
5. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.

IGNORE THE SMALLER figure of any grid number. These are for finding the full coordinates. Use ONLY THE LARGER figure of the grid number.

IF reporting beyond 10' in any direction, use the Grid Zone Designation, 14R1403897
