Pensacola was founded in 1559 by Spanish explorer Don Pedro Menéndez de Avilés. It was the first permanent European settlement in the United States. The city was destroyed by British forces in 1781 and again in 1821. It was rebuilt and became a major port and military installation. The city is known for its beautiful beaches, historic sites, and the Gulf Islands National Seashore.
