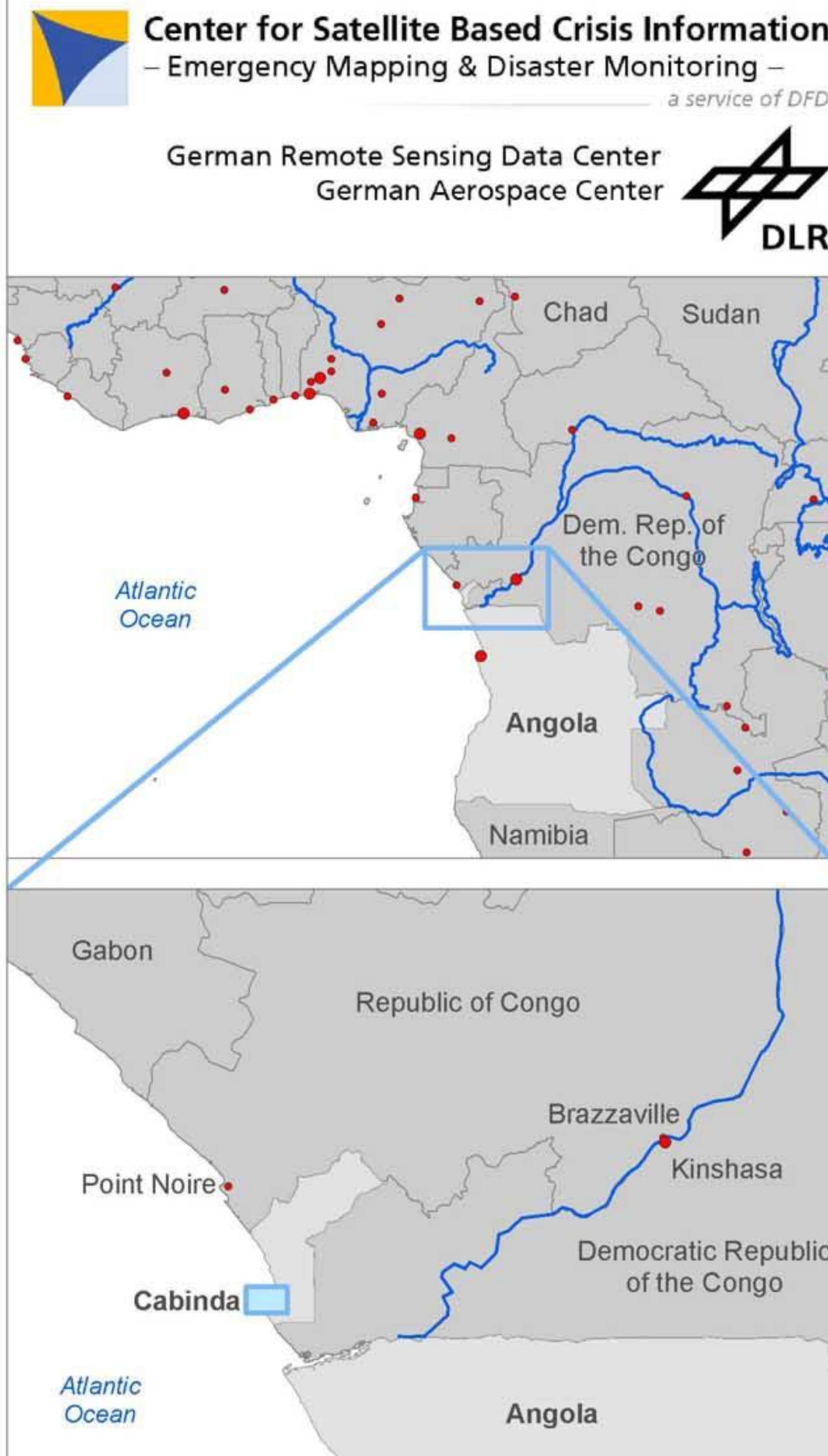


ANGOLA / CABINDA PROVINCE - Cabinda City Centre

Interpretation

The satellite map shows a high resolution IKONOS image of the city of Cabinda, Angola. The purpose of the map is to support the monitoring of a potential spreading of the Marburg virus in the city of Cabinda. It does not allow the identification of the disease itself, but will help to locate areas of concentration of potential infections. Furthermore, the satellite image maps are useful tools for orientation in the city and planning purposes.

For adjacent areas of Cabinda city please consider the 1:15.000 RESPOND map.

The map was produced in the framework of the ESA GMES Service Element "RESPOND" on request of the World Health Organisation (WHO).
