Tago River in Surigao Del Sur is an exposed rivermouth break that has fairly consistent surf, although summer tends to be mostly flat. Offshore winds are from the southwest. Waves more likely to be from local windswells than distant groundswells and the ideal wave angle is from the northeast. The beach break offers both left and right hand waves. Surfable at all stages of the tide. It very rarely gets crowded here. Watch out for dangerous rips.
