- > Place Joseph Etienne
- > Jardin de la Colline (bottom of Rue Vauvenargues)
- > Joan of Arc tank (Rue Vauvenargues – Montée de l'Oratoire)
- > Notre-Dame de la Garde + Museum of Sacred Art
