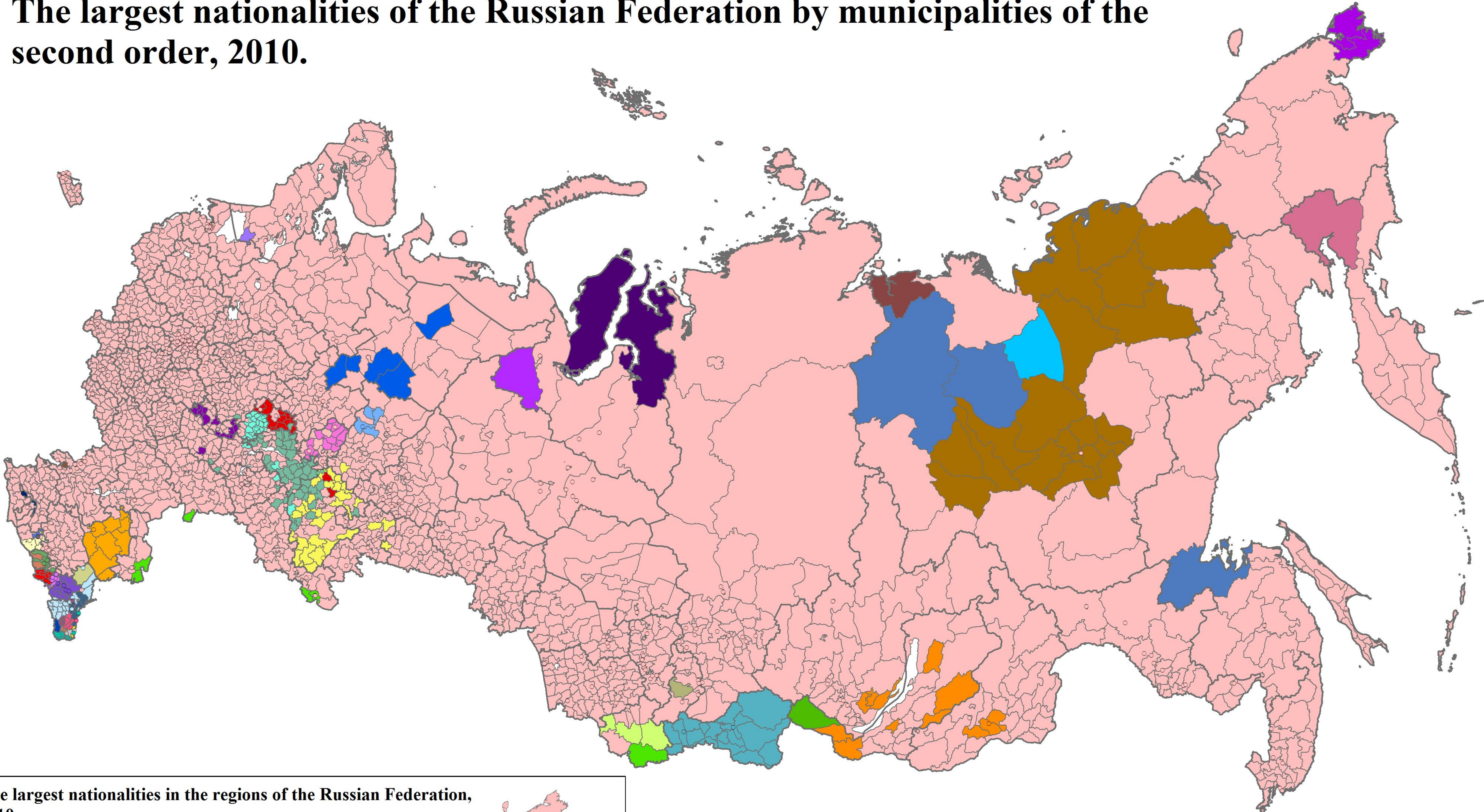


The largest nationalities of the Russian Federation by municipalities of the second order, 2010.
