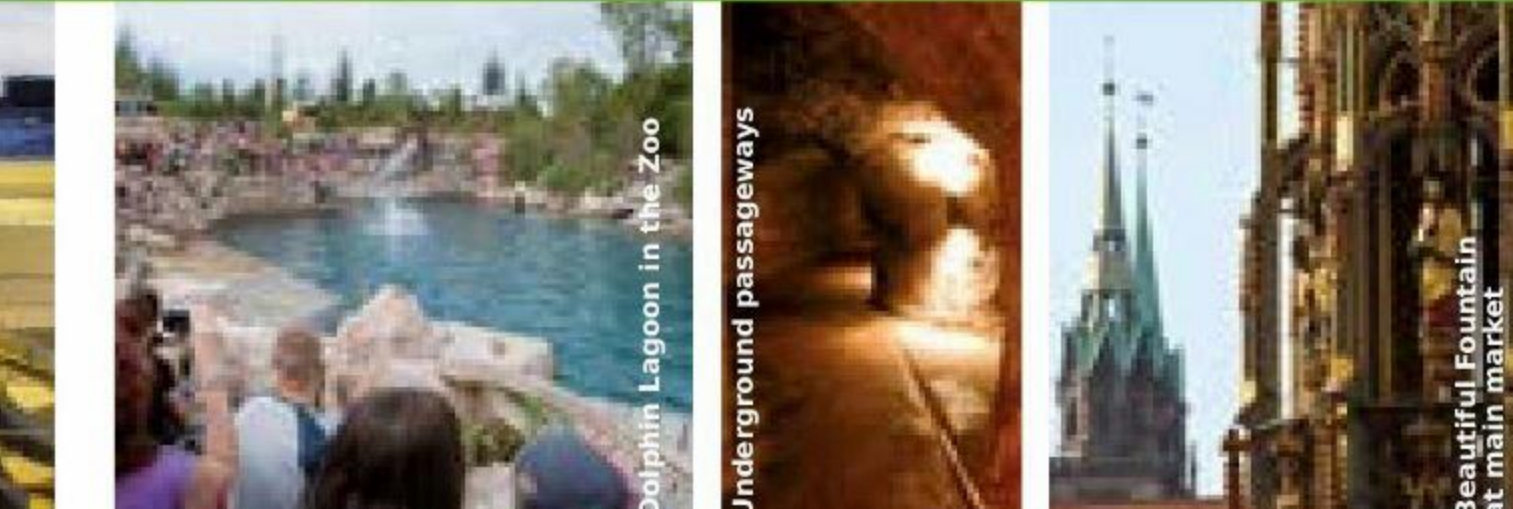
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Obligation to the Past

The Nazi Party Rally Grounds, laid out by Hitler's National Socialists, is a permanent reminder to Nuremberg of the city's obligation to analyze and discuss the darkest chapter of German history. The Documentation Center and the Memorial Nuremberg Trials explain on the original historical sites the causal factors and consequences of the National Socialist reign of terror as well as the significance of the International Military Tribunal.
