Castello Sforzesco was first built in 1368 by Galeazzo II Visconti and rebuilt in 1450 by Duke Francesco Sforza. Today, it houses the Trivulzio Library and several museums including the Civic Archaeological Museum and the Egyptian Museum. Masterpieces include Michelangelo's Pietà Rondanini.
