- 1 Federal Building**
Main Post Office, Tax Collector and Alaska Native Museum
- 2 Governor's Mansion**
Built in 1912, this elegant house houses the first family.
- 3 House of Wickham**
Home of Judge Wickham, who defined our territory's legal system and was a leading proponent of statehood.
- 4 St. Nicholas Russian Orthodox Church**
Built in 1894, it's the oldest original Russian Orthodox Church in Alaska.
- 5 Scottish Rite Temple**
Built in 1926, this Temple has a new, unique architectural style.
- 6 Capitol Building**
First laws in unincorporated Governor's Office, as well as historic photos.
- 7 Juneau-Douglas City Museum**
The museum offers artwork, mining and history exhibits, historical videos.
- 8 State Museum**
In previous exhibits of Alaska history and culture, wildlife displays and guided tours.
- 9 State Office Building**
The 10th floor houses a fully equipped pipe organ and an observation deck which offers a great view of Juneau and down the Gustavus Channel.
- 10 Windfall Fishermen**
A life-sized bronze bears their statue by local artist B.T. Wipf.
- 11 Centennial Hall Convention Center**
Historic photos, visitor information.
- 12 Municipal Building City Hall**
The city seal has a mural by local artist Edley depicting a historic mythology of coonmen.

- 13 Marine Park Kiosk**
A seasonal Visitor Information and selling structures staffed by local volunteers.
- 14 Hard Rock Miner**
A bronze sculpture in August Juneau's first dock moving engine by local artist Ed Wip.
- 15 Juneau Pioneers**
The bronze statue of Joe Juneau, Chief Klondike and Richard Harris are displayed on the outside of the Marine Store Building.
- 16 Penny Box**
Bronze sculptures and bronze statues were created by the sculptor in the 1930s.
- 17 Library/Parking Garage**
Alaskan historical reference resources, information and seasonal glass display.

- 18 USS Juneau Memorial**
This one-of-a-kind statue was dedicated by the Mayor's wife in 1942 and sunk that same year in connection with World War II.
- 19 Visitor Information (seasonal)**
Visitor information, local knowledge and photos.
- 20 Archie Van Winkle Memorial**
A statue in the Juneau is named after the Compressed Medal of Honor.
- 21 Fishermen's Memorial**
Fishermen and women who have given their lives to fishing.
