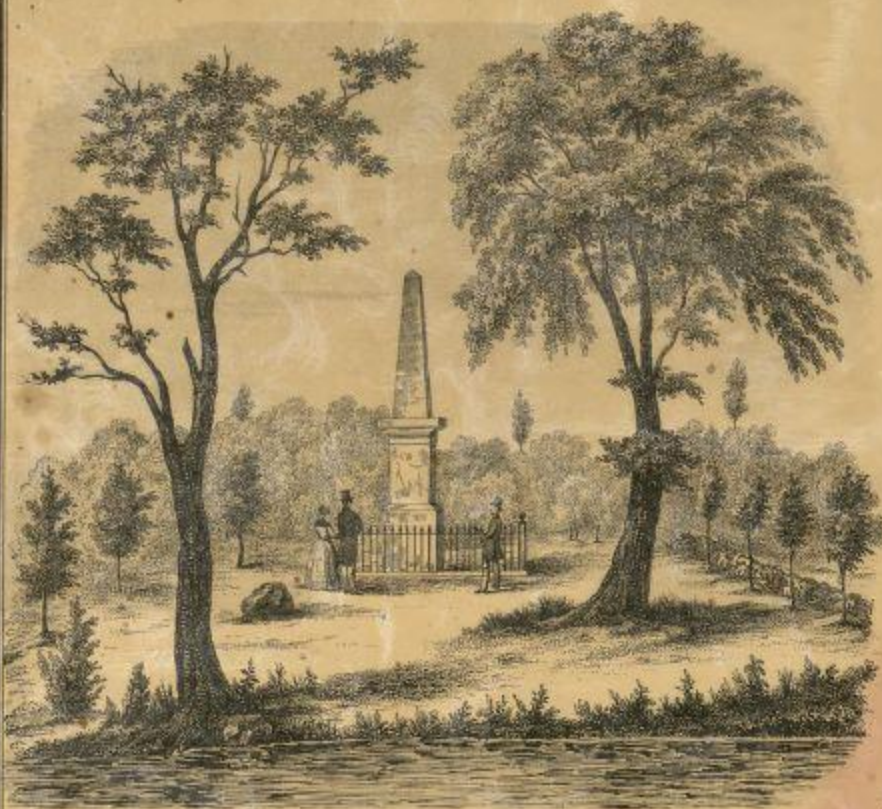




Monument at the "Old North Bridge."

MAP OF THE TOWN OF CONCORD

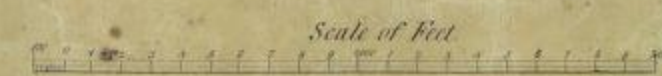
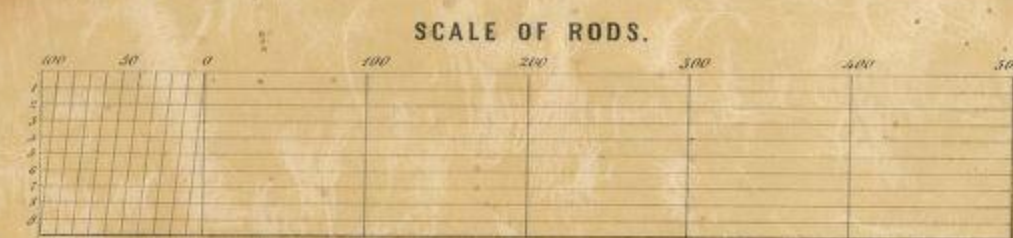
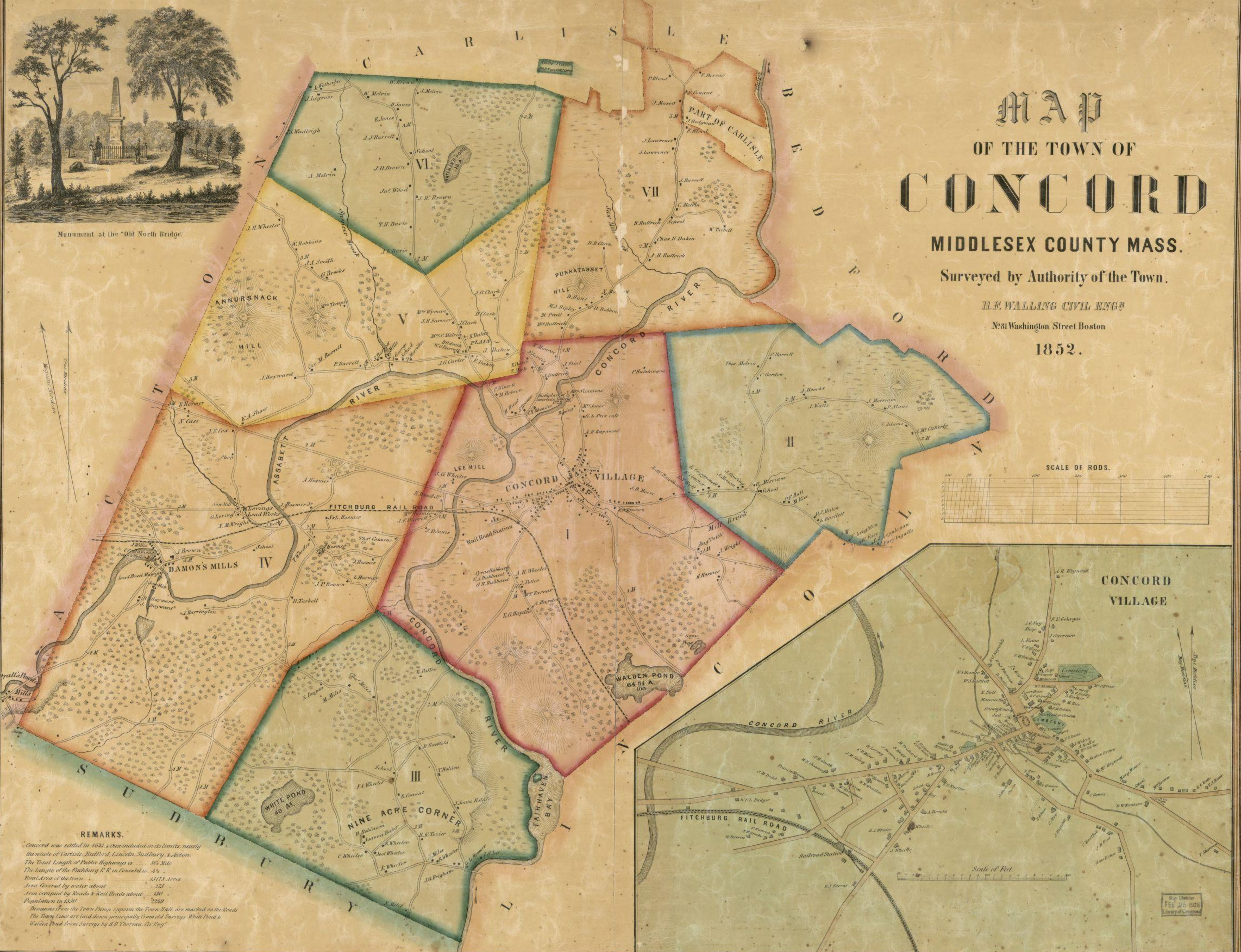

REMARKS.

Concord was settled in 1635, & then included in its limits, nearly the whole of Carlisle, Bedford, Lincoln, Sudbury, & Acton. The Total Length of Public Highways is 355 Miles. The Length of the Fitchburg R.R. in Concord is 4.5. Total Area of the town 4517.8 Acres. Area Covered by water about 275. Area occupied by Roads & Rail Roads about 150. Population in 1850 2229. Distances from the Town Pump, opposite the Town Hall, are marked on the Roads. The Town Lines are laid down principally from old Surveys. White Pond & Walden Pond from Surveys by A. D. Thorpe, Esq. Eng^r.
